HOW DO I REGISTER?

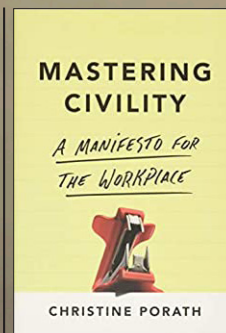

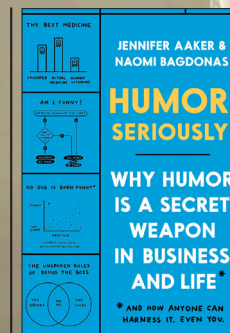
