#### **Insurance Events in Gamma Iota Sigma**

In February, Katie School Alumni from Gallagher presented on Cyber Insurance and trends in the industry. They talked about the importance of cyber policies and the process used in the case of a cyber-attack. Students had the unique opportunity to learn about a small but very significant piece of the industry. With recent cyberattacks on well-known companies such as

Target, Home Depot, and Anthem, this presentation gave a little bit more insight into an increasingly important area of insurance.

Another successful event that Gamma students attended was the Swiss Re Reinsurance Simulation in January, which was led by Katie School alumni. Swiss Re representatives came in to speak to students about

the reinsurance industry. They broke down the steps that are taken in writing a reinsurance policy, and afterwards students proceeded to give their own presentations on what advice they have for the "client." This was a really great chance for students to not only meet and network with alumni, but also learn about the reinsurance market and Swiss Re.



### 12th Annual NAPSLO Symposium

The 12<sup>th</sup> Extreme Risk Takers NAPSLO Symposium held in Chicago and hosted by the Derek Hughes/NAPSLO Educational Foundation, the Alpha Kappa Chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma and the Katie School of Insurance at Illinois State University was another great success. Over 170 students from 24 different universities from the U.S. and Canada attended making it the largest Symposium to date. Students became more knowledgeable in the field of surplus lines insurance and heard from various industry professionals within the surplus lines industry. There were eight different sessions throughout the weekend ranging from Underwriting in the Surplus lines Industry, to Lloyd's and the Global Market. The NAPSLO Symposium also allowed students to network with RMI students who share the same interest in a career in the risk management and insurance industry. A special thanks to NAPSLO and the Derek Hughes/NAPSLO Educational Foundation for the support to offer this Symposium to future industry leaders.

#### 7th Annual Gamma Games






